The Alpha course is an eleven-week opportunity to explore the validity and relevance of the Christian faith today centered around a meal, a video presentation, and small group discussion.

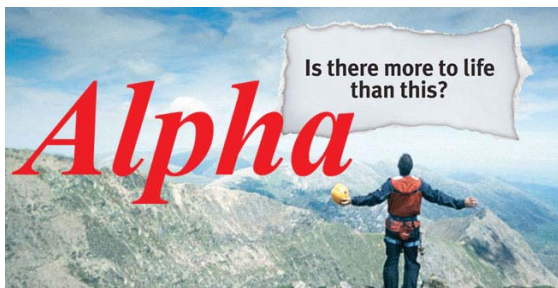
Who should come?
